23-192 Cllr Parkin was proposed by Cllr Hughes, seconded by Cllr Broader, and agreed by all present.

<u>Community Action Group (CAG) appointments – Chairperson, councillor</u> <u>representative and non-elected members</u>

- 23-196 Cllr Stella Hughes was proposed by Cllr Parkin, seconded by Cllr Broader and agreed by all present to take on the role of Chair of the Community Action Group.
- 23-197 Cllr Broader agreed to join the committee.
- 23-198 The CAG non-elected membership is to be carried forward to their next meeting at which a review of the Terms of Reference of the Group will be undertaken. The review will include:
 - i. the aims and objectives of the CAG
 - ii. the number of non-elected members for the group
 - iii. the quoracy required for a CAG meeting to proceed

<u>Events Working Group (EWG) – councillor member</u>

- 23-199 It was agreed that:
 - i. the chairperson of the EWG be confirmed by the Group.
 - ii. Cllr Parkin and the Clerk attend meetings of EWG.

External bodies – appointment of representatives

- 23-200 The following appointments were agreed:
 - Springfields First School: Cllr Treen
 - Yarnfield Park Residents' Association: Cllr Treen and Cllr Griffiths
 - Yarnfield Park Conference Centre: Clerk
 - BIFFA: Cllr David Beeston
 - Village Hall Committee: Cllr David Beeston
 - Stone Area Parish Council Liaison Group: the parish council will endeavour to send a councillor to each liaison group meeting.

HS2 – SRCG representation and support

- 23-201 The Council reaffirmed its commitment to work with the Stone Rail Head Crisis Group (SRCG) and resolved that:
 - i. The SRCG continues to advise the Council on matters relating to the HS2 phase 2A developments.
 - ii. A representative from the SRCG be invited to attend future meetings of the Council to advise on HS2 phase 2A developments
 - iii. Cllr Hughes and Cllr Broader agreed to represent the Council on the SRCG

<u>General Powers of Competence - annual review of eligibility</u>

- 23-202 At the June 2022 meeting of the Parish Council [minute 22-296] the council resolved to adopt the general power of competence and in so doing confirmed it met the eligibility criteria for adoption. In that:
 - At least 2/3 of the councillors were elected rather than co-opted, and,
 - The Clerk had an approved qualification.
- 23-203 To continue to rely on the General Power of Competence the Parish Council must, at every Annual Meeting that falls in the year of a parish council election, confirm that it still meets the eligibility criteria.
- 23-204 **Resolution**: It was resolved that:
 - i. The Parish Council continues to meet the criteria for adoptions.
 - ii. To adopt the General Power of Competence.

Review and re-adoptions of key documents

- 23-205 **Resolution**: It was resolved that the following policies were re-adopted, and any changes noted.
 - i. <u>Standing Orders</u>- amended to reflect formation of the personnel committee.
 - ii. <u>Financial Regulations</u> -typographic and formatting changes only.
 - iii. <u>Councillor Code of Conduct</u> The parish council has chosen to adopt the code of conduct prepared by Stafford Borough Council. In 2022 the

Borough Council adopted a revise code of conduct based on the updated model standard code prepared by the Local Government Association.

- iv. <u>Asset Register</u> the register has been updated to include the equipment inherited from the former Fete Committee and new benches that replaced the wooden bench on the village green and one on Footpath 11.
- v. <u>Risk Register</u> No changes have been made that affect the risk scores in the register. However strategic risk 1 and 3 have been updated to incorporate work being done by the parish council

<u>Forward Plan</u>
